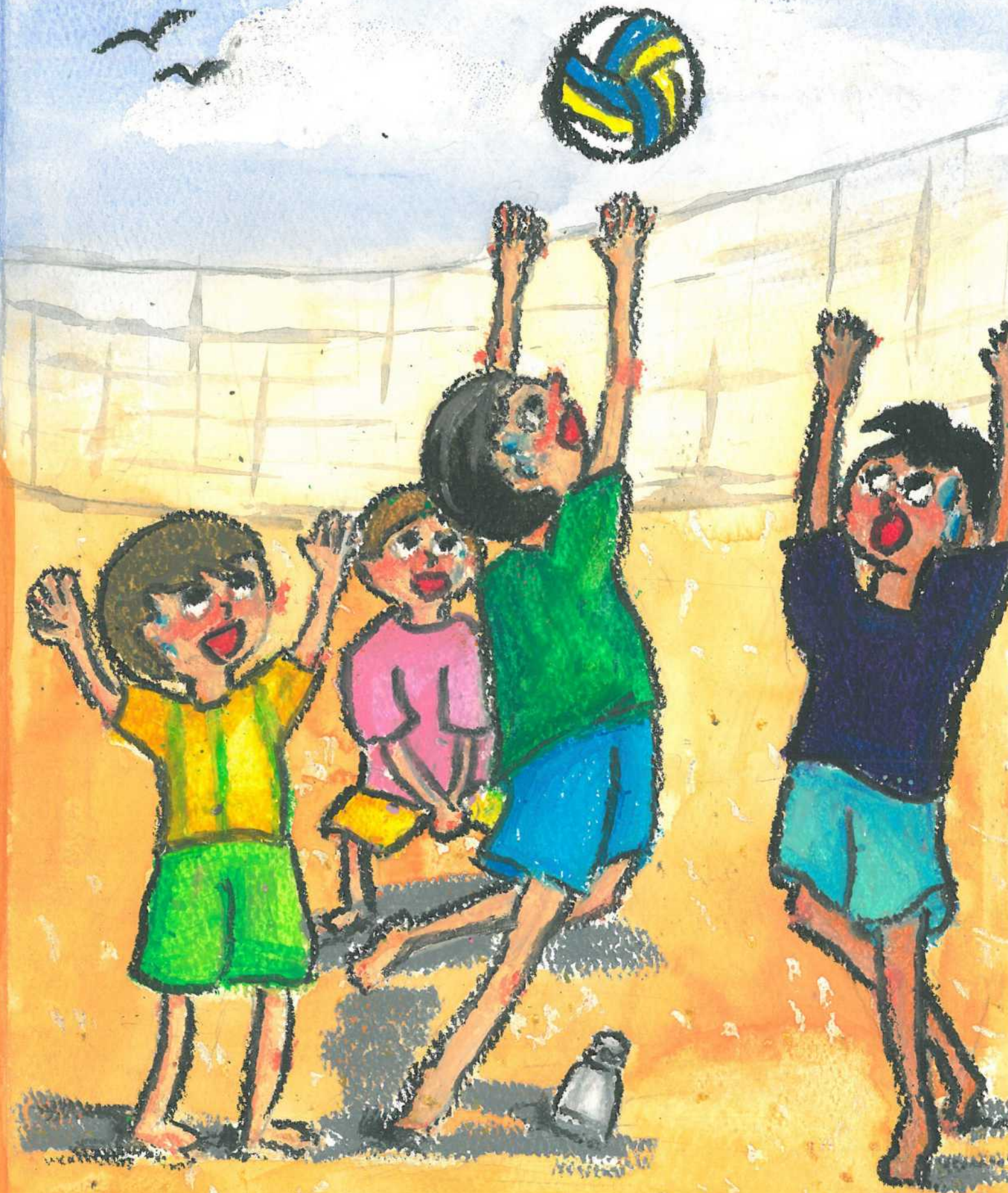


In summer, many visitors are attracted to the beach.

to pick up trash at any time, and to have the habit of sorting trash properly.



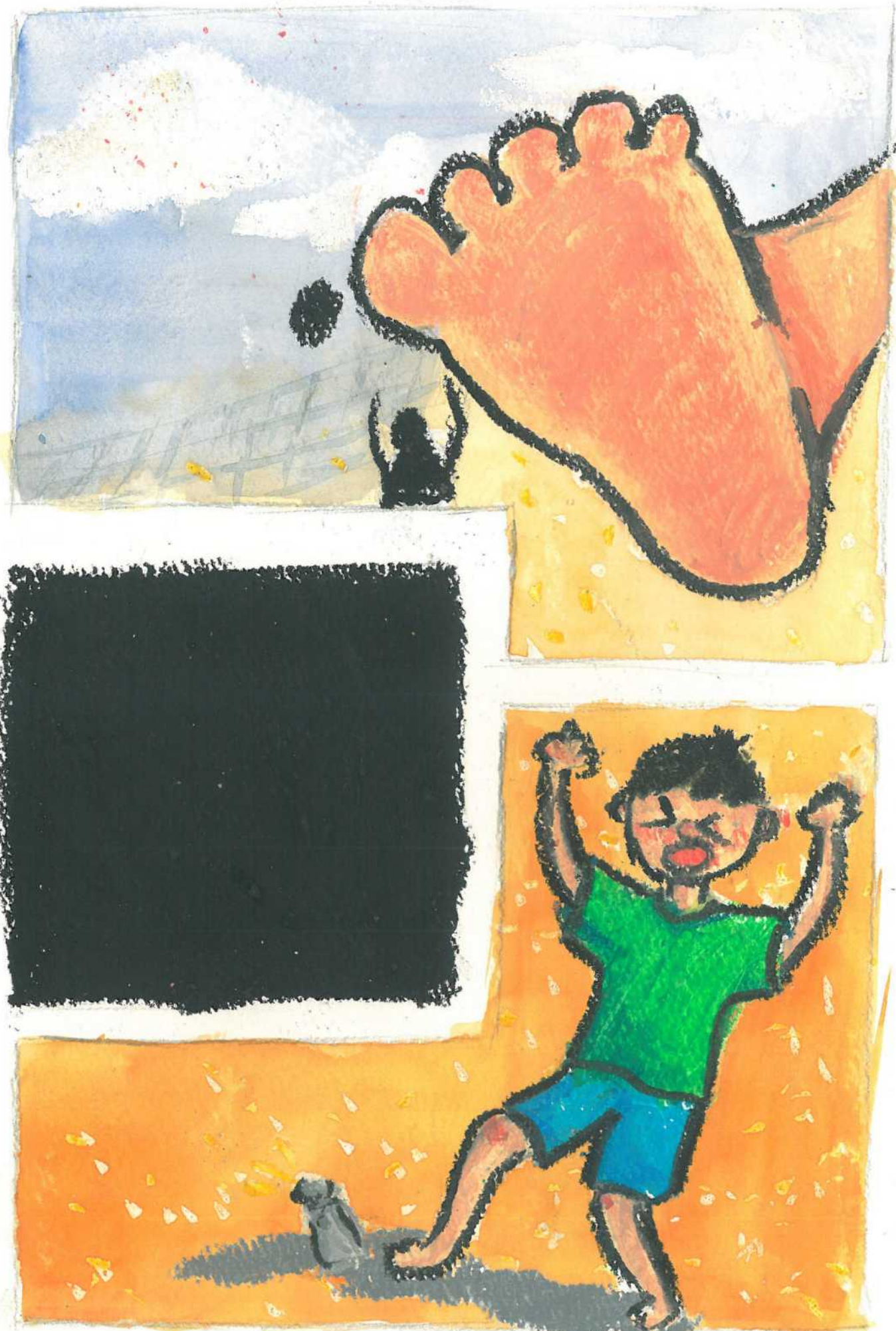

On the sand beach, a plastic bottle was waiting to go home.



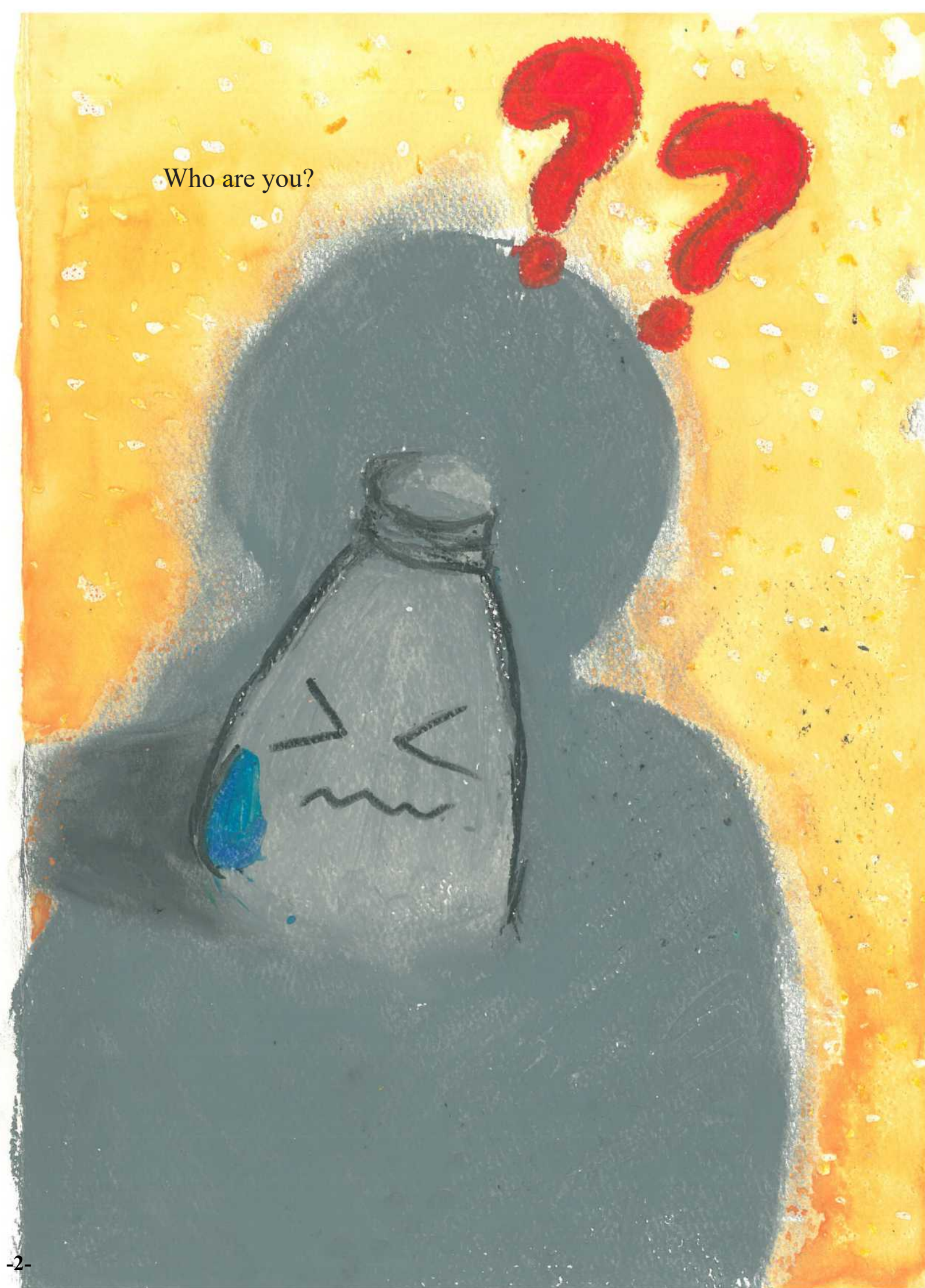
One day, a bunch of boys came to play volleyball on the beach.

Who are you?






I am a plastic bottle, and I have been wandering on this beach for a long time.
I want a home. Would you please find a home for me?

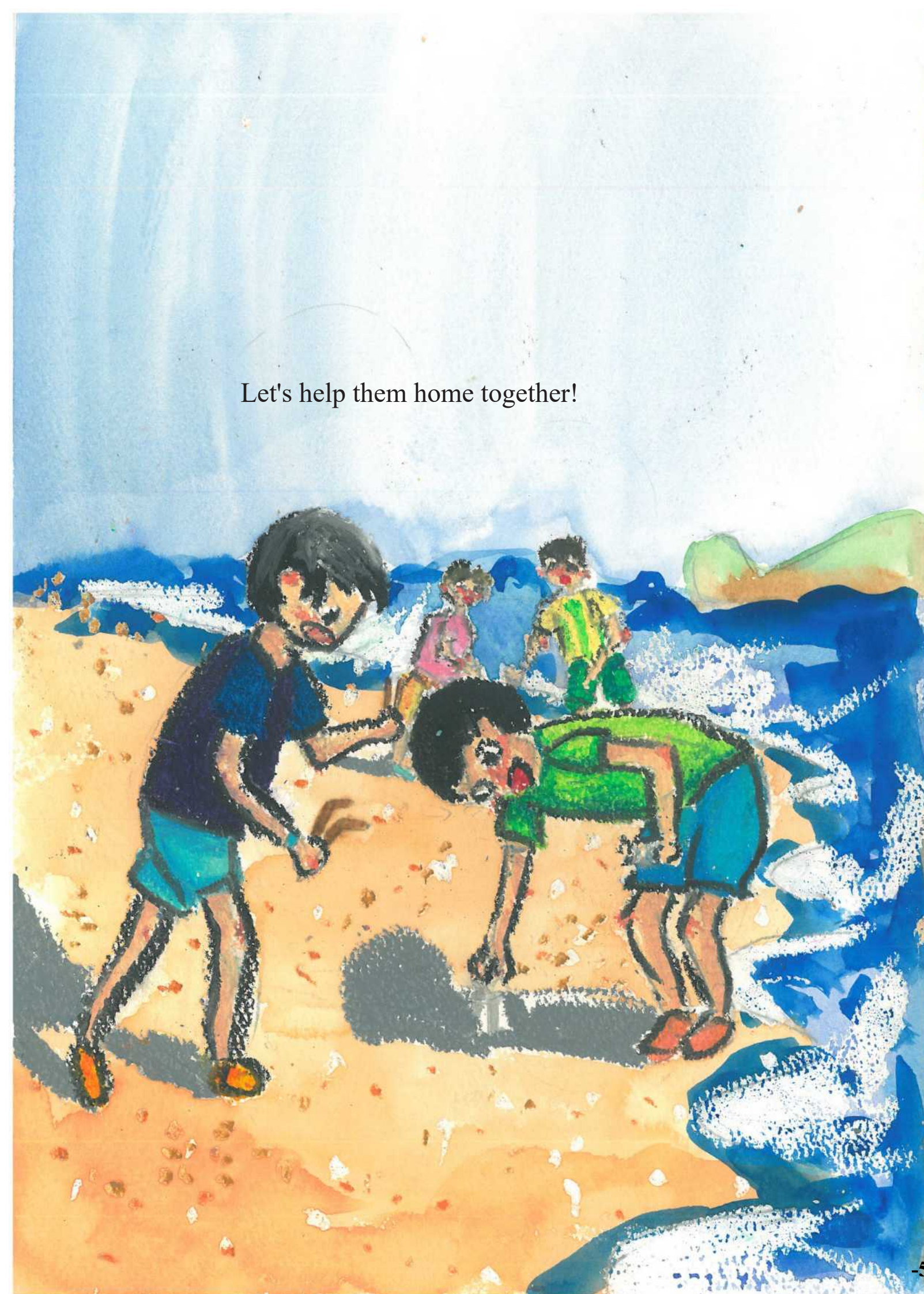
No problem! agreed these boys, without the slightest hesitation.

There were beverage packs, tissue paper, straws, plastic bags, disposable chopsticks, and so on. Each of them had been wandering for a long time and wished to go home.



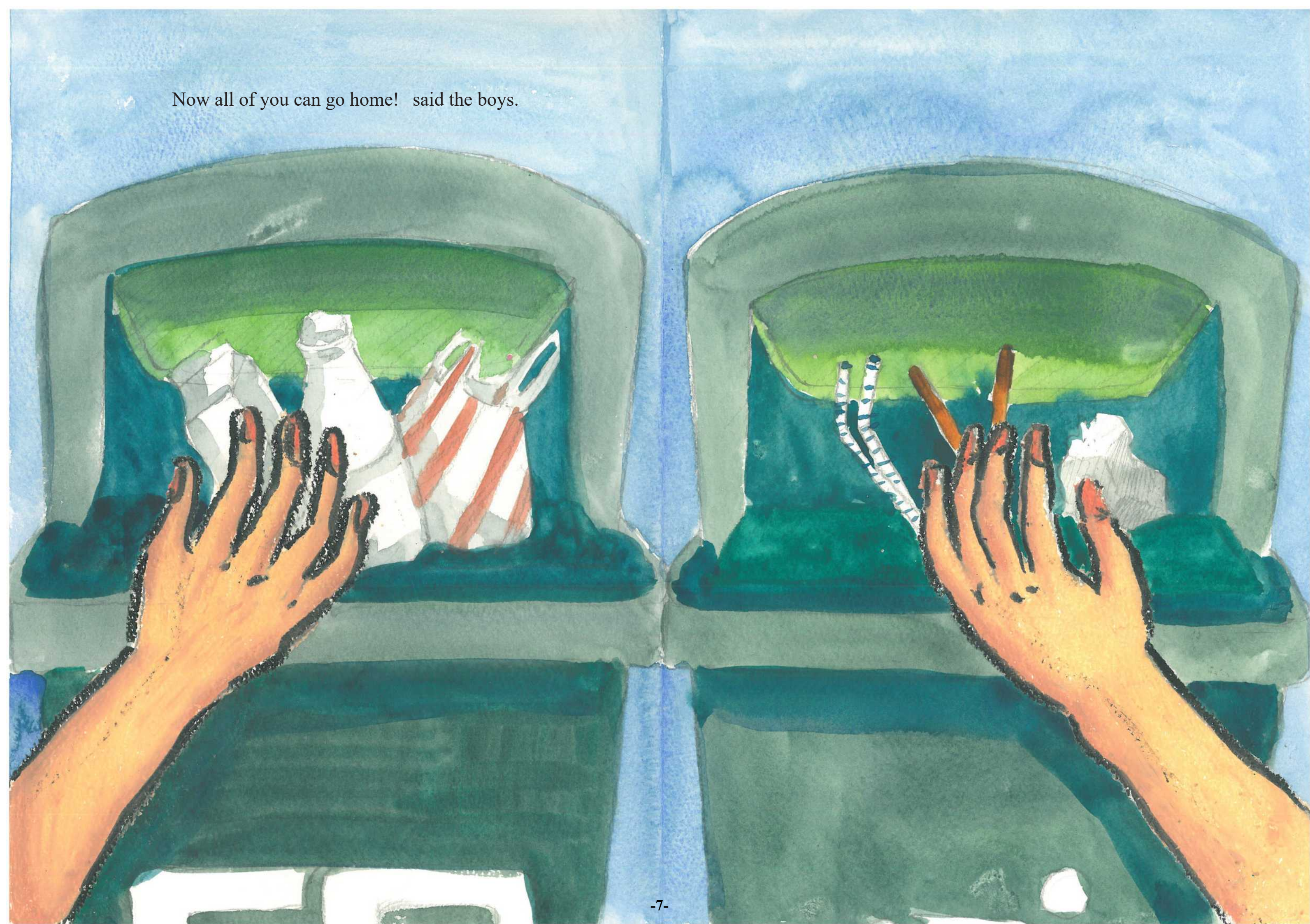
See, there are two trash cans over there.
